# The Tribulation

The beast mentioned in the 13th chapter of Revelation will come to this earth. Century old prophesies are coming to pass, just as God has ordained. This beast or antichrist is foretold to appear with the approach of doomsday (*Listen to the explanation of Revelation 13 here*).

He will perform great miracles right from the start. The whole world will be amazed at the things he can do and follow after him blindly, raving and in awe of his powers. He will make thousands of disciples out of unsuspecting people (Rev 13:2-18).

Great sicknesses will engulf the earth—plagues. Many diseases that are fatal are continually on the rise (Rev. 9:18; 6:8). Many other people are slated to die by war (Rev. 9:15).

But the good news is there will be a few who will escape that time of testing (Rev. 3:10). They will be spared (Mal. 3:16-17). They will be accounted worthy to escape what is coming and be allowed to stand before Jesus Christ when He returns (Luke 21:36). This small group of people will be granted to remain alive until Jesus Christ returns (1 Thess. 4:17; Luke 12:32). This small group will be taken to a place of safety and hidden from the beast (Rev. 12:14-16).

Satan, however, is allowed to go after those who are left behind, those lukewarm for good works for God's glory in Jesus' name (Rev. 3:15-16; 12:17; Col. 3:17). By their death they shall be

saved (Rev. 13:7; 6:11; 14:13; 11:18; 20:4). This is why it pays to be wholehearted for God now, while there is still a short time left (Jer. 17:9; 21:8; 23:20; 30:23-24; Ezek. 14:14; 18:32).

## The Tribulation

The Lord tells the righteous, who have been spared, to hide in the Rock and enter their rooms (Is. 2:10-11; 26:20-21). Hide the outcast from the beast (Is. 16:4). It will take awhile to get to that place of safety (Is. 21:13-15). When we go into our rooms the Lord will go out and fight our enemies for us (Is. 42:11-13). The Lord will conceal us in His dwelling place (Psalm 27:5; 32:7). Notice, "the Rock" God, tells the righteous not to be afraid (Is. 44:6-8). This place of safety will be a rock (Is. 33:16). Many of you know where that is (See our place of safety Scriptures here).

The final coming of the Savior would signal the end of the present world. He would judge the righteous and annihilate the wicked. We know the righteous will be the true followers of Jesus Christ who will not receive the mark of the beast or antichrist (Rev. 20:4). This antichrist will fulfill the Scriptures that are found in Revelation 13:3-14. Only Jesus Christ Himself can destroy this beast, and destroy him He will, when He returns (Rev. 19:20; 20:10). At the end of Jesus' thousand year reign, after Satan has been loosed for a short time, Satan himself will be thrown into the lake of fire with his evil angels (Ezek. 28:18-19).

God has a book, and it is called the "book of remembrance." In that book go all of the names of the people who will be spared (Mal. 3:16-17), those who serve God with their whole heart (Mal. 3:18; Matt. 4:10). God is going to seek from that book (Is. 34:16-17).

Whoever continues to sin willingly, after knowing the truth, will be blotted out of that book (Ex. 32:33). We must be overcomers in order to keep your name from being erased from that book (Rev. 3:5). We must use God's Holy Spirit and crucify the flesh with its evil passions and desires, by doing good, and not become weary in doing so (Titus 3:8; 2 Thess. 3:13; Gal. 6:9; Rom. 12:21; 1 Peter 3:11). We must put those who will not live for God to shame by our deeds, as they see us continually do good for God's glory (1 Peter 2:12). The word Gentile means those who do not know God or serve Him. This would mean that the majority of those who profess to know God really don't know Him and therefore, deny Him because they remain worthless for any good deeds for God (Titus 1:16).

Let's all strive to enter that narrow door of overcoming evil by doing good so we will be written in the Lord's book of life and abide forever (Luke 13:24; Psalm 37:27-29; 34:13-14). ## The Coming of the Antichrist

The Bible tells us, the antichrist will come. He looks like a man, and talks very smoothly. He will display himself to the world as God the Creator (2 Thess. 2:4). Just as Jesus Christ was God incarnate, Satan will manifest himself in the flesh and be called a son, however, he will be the son of destruction and will be very deceptive (2 Thess. 2:3). This religious deception is allowed by God the Father for the judgment of this world for its sins.

In this day and age, with television, the internet and social media broadcasting worldwide events instantaneously, it makes sense this man-beast would most likely use all of them, when he appears, to affect millions of people with a spirit of delusion and the world will never be the same again (Rev. 13:2-18). He will do many things that will amaze people and they will follow after him blindly while saying, "Who is like (as great as) the beast, and who is able to wage war against him?" And the beast was given a mouth (the power of speech), uttering great things and arrogant and blasphemous words, and he was given freedom and authority to act and to do as he pleased for forty-two months (three and a half years) (Rev. 13:4-5 AMP). When you see this happen, you will know the end is near.

The television, internet and social media, have always been instruments of Satan from the very beginning. Satan has done a marvelous job keeping you distracted and entertained, so you won't have time to entertain what is godly. Isn't it obvious that these things are meant to consume your thoughts and provoke you to things of the world, all while wasting precious time? In fact, it would be best not to be involved with these things, until you have gained self control and a godly perspective when it comes to these things. God does not want us to look upon or be involved with things which are not pleasing to Him. God's word tells us He hates those who watch any kind of violence—whether it's sports, action movies, murder mysteries or westerns, it really makes no difference - violence is violence (Psalm 11:5). To that end, the television, internet and social media are full of things God does not condone. Galatians 5:19-21 (NIV) lists many other things that are displeasing: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. These things are all over television and the internet and promoted on social media.

We must be sober and on the alert for the Lord's coming so we will not be caught unaware and distracted by this world (1 Pet. 5:8; 2 Pet. 3:3, 10). The truth of how to overcome and enter the kingdom of heaven will be preached in all the world. People will learn how to be reconciled to the true God of heaven. Those people who do not receive a love for the truth by being zealous in doing good works from the heart will be sent a spirit of delusion from the Lord. They will believe the lie of Satan and be judged because they were not willing to repent, when they heard the truth (2 Thess. 2:9-12).

Don't you think it's time to wake up and obey God while you still can? Stop allowing the world, and its ruler Satan, to distract you with things that are futile (1 Sam. 12:21; 1 John 5:19). You need to prepare for all that is to come now so you will be ready, and wise as a serpent, as Bible prophecies take place (Matt. 10:16 AMP). # Follow These Directions



When we see the words, "Follow these directions," it can incite inner rebellion in our natures that goes something like this:

A. "I don't need to follow anyone's directions. My inner intelligence will tell me if I'm on the right track."

B. "I hate to read directions."

C. "I don't need to follow these directions. It's probably just this man's opinion, and I have an opinion of my own."

#### "It is also imperative to realize that nothing works well without directions."

It's imperative to realize that mankind is hostile in regard to any kind of obedience to directions, especially if they come from God. It is also imperative to realize that nothing works well without directions. For example, you cannot build a car, play a piano or be successful at going to

the moon without following directions. The same is true for salvation.

# "Jesus' words are the directions to the repentant life we are to live to be saved."

How many times have you goofed and said, "I suppose I should have read the directions, but I didn't. I made a terrible mistake, and now I must do it all over again!" This is what Jesus meant when He said, "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who does not enter by the door into the fold of the sheep, but climbs up some other way, is a thief and a robber" (John 10:1). We know that the door represents Jesus, and if we keep, do and put Jesus' words into practice daily, we shall never see death, but we will have everlasting life (Luke 13:24; John 10:9; 8:51). Jesus' words are the directions to the repentant life we are to live to be saved (John 12:47-50).

Going to church can't save you, praying to God can't save you, religious doctrines won't save you, even seminary training in the Bible can't save you and having a title of a minister can't save you. Only daily obedience to Jesus Christ's words can and will save you (John 3:36; Mark 7:7).

#### "Jesus gave precise directions to those who would follow Him in the Sermon on the Mount."

Jesus gave precise directions to those who would follow Him in the Sermon on the Mount, mentioned in Matthew, chapters 5, 6 and 7. In summation of those words, He said, "Therefore, everyone who hears these words of Mine and acts on them [keeps them, does them and puts them into practice daily in their lives] will be wise" (Matt. 7:24).

The keeping of Jesus' words, then, is doing God's Will (Mark 3:34-35; Luke 8:21). Jesus' spiritual words that came from the Father are the

directions to eternal life, as well as how to repent and how God wants to be worshiped (John 6:63; Luke 11:28). Then, we are to study Jesus Christ's words daily, not only to show ourselves approved by God, but to find out what the perfect Will of God is. God's Will is to practice doing those things which please Him daily (2 Tim. 2:15 King James Version; Rom. 12:2). It's as simple as that.

It has been shown that we must keep Jesus' words to obtain eternal life, and that it is a way we must live if we are to say we truly believe (John 8:51; 10:26; Luke 6:46). 
"When you perform God's Will daily in your life, you are living in the Spirit or walking in the Spirit, and you will not carry out the evil desires of the flesh."

"These are the true directions from God's own word on how we are to enter the good life, which is God's Way of life, and receive all the blessings that come from that precious Way of life."


